

## Reynolds Plantation Clubhouse Restaurant Dress Code

Dress code policies apply to all adults, children, and guests. Members are responsible for the attire of their children and guests. Members should inform their guests of the dress code prior to their arrival at the club.

### Policy

The accepted norm is **Country Club Casual** referring to attire that is permissible on Reynolds Plantation golf courses. Any attire that is more casual or informal than this broad guideline is not acceptable. A few exceptions are:

**Children** under ten years old are encouraged to follow the above policy, but are permitted to wear \*t-shirts and \*denim jeans that are neat and clean in appearance.

**Gentlemen** will remove caps and hats in all clubhouse dining rooms and lounges. Sleeveless shirts are not permitted at any time. \*Neat and clean denim jeans are allowed in all clubhouse dining rooms, lounges, verandas, and The Crow's Nest. **The only exception to this policy is in the Creek Club Dining Room** after 5:00 PM. Golf attire and open-toed shoes are acceptable in all dining rooms, lounges, and verandas.

**Ladies** are permitted to wear dress \*denim jeans in all areas of the Clubhouses at all times.

**\*T-shirts** for men and women are permitted in all areas of the Plantation Grille, Great Waters Overlook and the Landing Clubhouses until 5:00 PM. After 5:00 PM, \*T-shirts may only be worn in the Plantation Lounge and Veranda, Great Waters Overlook Lounge and Veranda, and the Landing Veranda. T-Shirts are not permitted in the Creek Club Dining room at any time.

**Tennis attire** is not acceptable in the dining rooms after 5:00 PM.

**Swimsuits** may only be worn in pool areas and at the snack bars, and never in clubhouse dining areas.

The dress code is an opportunity to show respect for fellow members and to allow for an enjoyable experience in all dining venues. If management encounters attire considered inappropriate or inconsistent with our policy, members or their guests may be denied service or access.

If there is any uncertainty by members regarding the dress code, please contact Member Concierge or the clubhouse restaurant directly.

**\*Denim:** *acceptable denim must be clean and neat in appearance without holes or frayed.*

**\*T-Shirts:** *must be clean, neat, without holes, and have no offensive language.*
